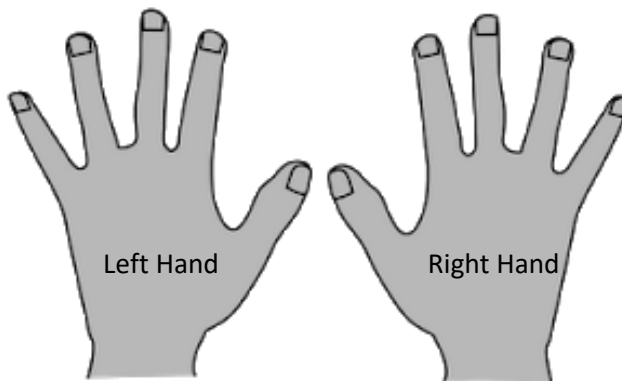


# Handout 1 – Fingering Chart
